Stabilization and Treatment Home Program

- Initial structure informed by technical assistance and feedback by the University of Maryland Institute of Innovation and Implementation
- Analysis of various models utilized by peer states
- DHHR and child placing agencies (CPAs) working collaboratively on STAT Home model
- CPAs have provided feedback to further refine model

Stabilization and Treatment Home Program

- Community based model of care for children in foster care with serious emotional disorders (SED) requiring intensive short-term behavioral health intervention
- **STAT Home:** Family alternative to residential placement for children in foster care requiring a behavioral health intervention
- Provides short-term intervention in a stable, family-like setting with a goal of returning home or another family setting
- **Eligible children:** Children in foster care who are approved for the Children with Serious Emotional Disorder (CSED) Waiver that cannot be safely served in their own, kinship, or traditional or tiered foster home and require a treatment home to receive behavioral health interventions

Initial STAT Home Certification Requirements

- STAT Home certification requirements include initial, ongoing and family-specific trainings
- Certification monitored by DHHR
- Topics include:
 - Children with Exceptional Needs training
 - Advanced crisis prevention, intervention and de-escalation
 - Advanced behavior support
 - Advanced trauma training
 - Advanced training on childhood disorders

Measures and Monitoring

- DHHR and CPAs collaborating on measures
- Measures focus on utilizing STAT Homes as a diversion to residential treatment

STAT Home Model Implementation

- Implementation plan under development and will be refined through collaboration between DHHR and CPAs
- Recruitment planning underway
